Knox County Regional Airport Noise Compatibility Program

To All Pilots Using the Knox County Regional Airport...

Like all communities having an airport in their midst, our airport neighbors understand the need for the airport, but are appreciative of any efforts to reduce aircraft noise and low flying. We offer the following voluntary procedures for arrival and departure and count on responsible pilots to follow them.

Night Curfew Hours (Voluntary)

Between **10:30 p.m.** and **6:00 a.m.** local time.

Prohibited Operations

Between **10:30 p.m.** and **6:00 a.m.**, the following operations are **prohibited**: Touch and go landings, maintenance run-ups, and extended APU operations.

Time Limited for Aircraft Idling at the Terminal

All aircraft parked on the ramp at the terminal building shall shut down all engines if the anticipated hold time at the terminal will be longer than 15 minutes.

Propeller and Turbo-Propeller Driven Aircraft Arrivals

Use left-hand traffic pattern at an altitude of 1,056 feet MSL (mean sea level). Maintain 1,000 feet AGL (above ground level) on downwind and keep the base leg inside North Shore Drive or fly a wide pattern over the water on the downwind and base.

Propeller and Turbo-prop aircraft are requested to use Runway 21 for arrivals and departures when winds are five knots or less. Maintain 1000'

AGL on downwind and keep the base leg inside North Shore Drive or fly a wide pattern over the water on downwind and base.

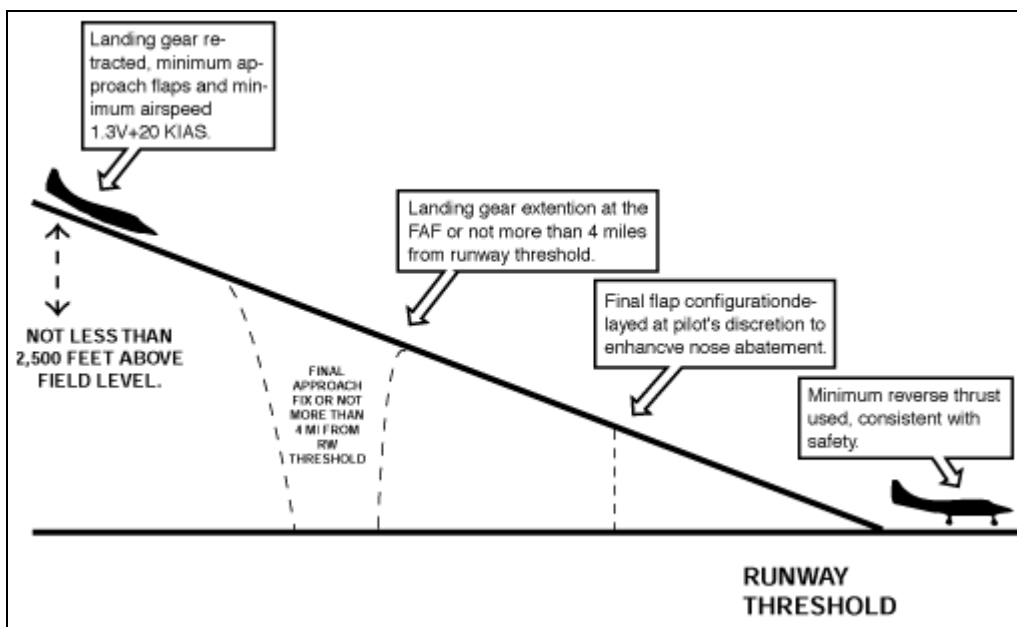
Runway 13 has a noise sensitive area one mile from the approach end. Fly as high as safety permits on final. If possible, stay left of the centerline until on short final.

Runway 31 has a noise sensitive area under the final approach. Cross the shoreline at 600 feet or above. If possible, stay right of centerline.

Jet Aircraft Arrivals

Jet operators are requested to use NBAA approach procedures. Use Runway 31 whenever possible, if wind conditions permit.

When using the Runway 13 ILS approach, remain at or above the glide path until inside one mile from the runway. Jet noise sensitive area is within one mile from the approach end of Runway 13.



All Aircraft Departures

Runways 03, 21, 13:

Climb straight ahead to 1000 feet AGL before turning on course unless remaining in the traffic pattern or using a downwind departure pattern turn left at 700 feet AGL.

Runway 31:

Noise sensitive area one mile off the departure end. If possible, turn 10 degrees right to avoid this area until at least 1000 feet AGL.

Runway 13:

Noise sensitive area near shore. If possible, turn 10 degrees left until at least 1000 feet AGL.

Jet Noise is a big problem.

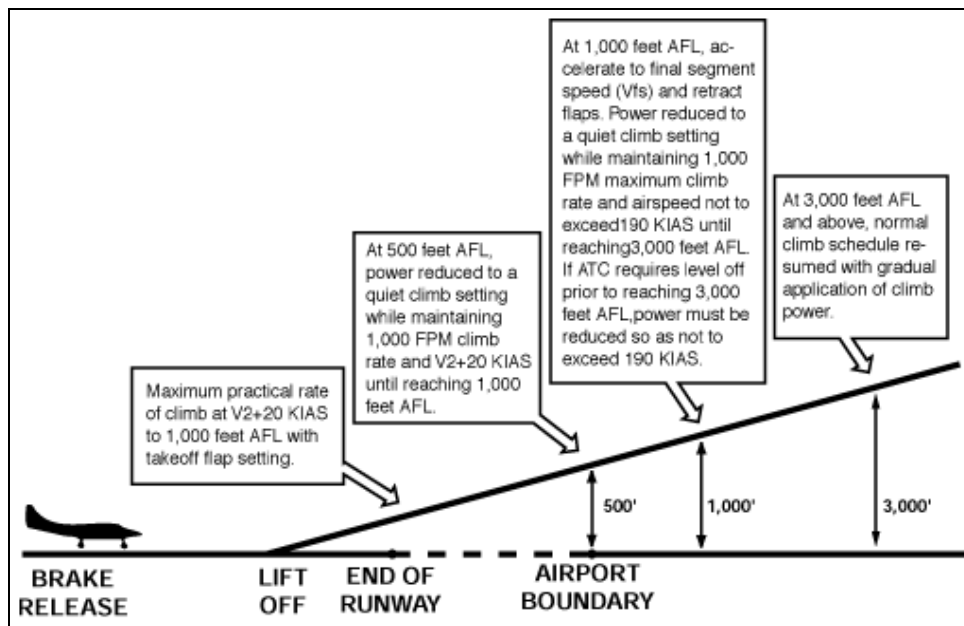
Please use NBAA “Close-In” Noise Abatement departure procedures.

Please reduce Pilot Control Lighting intensity as soon as possible by using three clicks.
