1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of April 2003
2. Average daily inmate population: 56.37
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 23.9
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: 32.47
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 2 [1 @ 168; 1 @ 128]
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 04/30/03: \$2,470.00

14. Miscellaneous: During this reporting period 2 staff officers were injured intervening at court with a combative inmate; another officer was injured while attempting to control a combative inmate during the admission process. Throughout the month we were compelled to board out 4 inmates per day to Hancock County. We were compelled to resort to contingency housing for 1 day. During this month the board fees INCURRED by the agency amounted to \$8,280. Clinicians from M-CMHC responded to the facility to conduct 13 mental health assessments at the request of staff. Meals served have exceeded projections for FY2003 to date by 2,250. Roof repairs in progress damaged the security electrical system resulting in a shutdown of various intercoms, lights and control of security locks from the control panel.
