1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of August 2003
2. Average daily inmate population: 61.39
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 28.1
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: 33.29
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 4 [1 @ 260; 1 @ 220; 1 @ 182; 1 @ 155]
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 08/31/03: \$2,470.00

14. Miscellaneous: 23 mental health crisis interventions or assessments were requested for inmates during the month. Interventions resulting in 1 suicide watch and 1 involuntary commitment. Repairs to the facility attributed to the roofing project continued, including restoration of full electrical power to the library. Contingency housing was opened for 3 days during the reporting period. The inmate population continued to set facility records for the 7th consecutive month. This reporting period experienced the largest inmate population for the same period in facility's history (an increase of 48.3% over the previous record for August) and saw the 3rd largest inmate population for the year. Meals served year-to-date exceed projections by 5,029.
