14. Miscellaneous: This reporting period saw the highest average inmate population in the facility's history. During this month a maximum security, pre-trial/non-search inmate escaped from custody at the courthouse. Having escaped on the 26<sup>th</sup>, he was recaptured on the 28<sup>th</sup> without incident. During the period when the inmate was at large there appeared to be no reports of criminal conduct attributable to him. Investigation of the escape and related security practices was initiated immediately and continues. Due to the increased inmate population meal projections for FY2003 to date were exceeded by 1,047.
