1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of June 2003
2. Average daily inmate population: 62.6
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 28.2
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: 34.4
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 4 [1 @ 229; 1 @ 189; 1 @ 151; 1 @ 124]

Miscellaneous: An inmate requested and received off-campus medical treatment during this reporting period; the procedure was performed, as day surgery, in Augusta, requiring transport and overtime. The Crisis Team from Mid-Coast Mental Health responded at staff request on 9 occasions during the reporting period for mental health interventions with inmates. The inmate population during June 2003 was the largest in the history of the facility. During this period an average of 7.9 inmates were boarded out to other facilities, incurring expenses in the amount of \$22,650.00 for the month. Total meals served during the year to date were reported to exceed projections by 3,791. Problems regarding various facility systems impacted by the roofing project continued throughout the month. During this period staffing continued to be a problem that was aggravated by use of vacation time, off-campus training and staff injuries. Due to an increased inmate population and no available room in any other county jail, contingency housing was initiated for the last 2 days of the month.
