14. Miscellaneous: **During this month meals served exceeded projections by 1,681 to date. This reporting period closed the quarter as the highest inmate population in the history of the facility and this month had the highest inmate population for the same period in the facility's history. The door pulls, obtained pursuant to a successful safety grant application, were installed on the most frequently used security doors. Additionally, security modifications were made to security doors in the medium housing section to correct tampering. Clinicians from Mid-Coast Mental Health Center responded to requests from staff 21 times for both crisis and non-crisis assessments and interventions re. inmates and, as a consequence, it was necessary to conduct 2 suicide watches. 3 staff members were attacked by combative inmates.**
