1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of November 2003
2. Average daily inmate population: 56.4
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 27.2
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: 29.2
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 3 [1 @ 306; 1 @ 161; 1 @ 131]
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 11/30/03: \$2,470.00
7. Average daily boarders: -0-
8. Counties represented by boarders: -0-
9. Total number of inmates hospitalized: -4-
10. Total days of hospitalization: -29-
11. Total OT hours occasioned by inmate hospitalization: -339-
12. Total number of staff injuries: -0-
13. Number of meals served: inmates: 4305 staff: 68
14. Miscellaneous: The 3 of the 4 inmate hospitalizations were the result of the "blue paper" process, i.e., involuntary mental health commitments. The 4<sup>th</sup> inmate, a maximum security inmate, required emergency surgery and, as a consequence of his security status, required 2 officers to guard him throughout the hospitalization. Meals served during this month exceeded projections year-to-date by 6,148. The month of November was the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest in inmate population for the agency, exceeded only by November 1999 (0.5+).
