2. Average daily inmate population: 68.55
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 33.97

5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 4 [1 @ 338; 1 @ 175; 1 @ 174; 1 @ 153]

14. Miscellaneous: Weekly pretrial inmate reports were resumed during this reporting period with a distribution to the District Attorney and the Clerk of Courts. At the request of the District Attorney, note was made of those inmates that were waiting for trial or sentencing 90 or more days. On average throughout the reporting period it was necessary to board OUT 13 inmates [at a cost of approximately \$102.00 per day per inmate]; all inmates were boarded at Cumberland County Jail. During February the largest, average daily inmate population in the history of the facility was recorded.
